VI Project Proposal**(i) Title of the Project Proposal :**

A Study of the problems and challanges in families died in Corona epidemic:With special refrence to Wardha District.

(ii) Abstract (approx. 200 words)

A nationwide lockdown was imposed in India on March 13, 2020 against the backdrop of the Korna virus epidemic. Therefore, various restrictions were imposed on all the people of India. These restrictions forced everyone to stay in their home during the lockdown period. Against this background a social gap was placed. Various measures have been taken by the government to reduce the impact of the corona virus. But all these measures were only for the prevention of corona virus. There was no definite effective solution. Therefore, the number of corona infections and deaths during this period was very high. Not only in India but the whole world was going through this process. Since no vaccine was available, there were no specific measures to apply. In that case, if the head of the family died, the whole family would be devastated. Husband, wife, son, daughter, parents, if any member of the family dies, it affects the whole family. The family that was going through all these processes faced many kinds of problems. The whole family was devastated when the elders of some families passed away. In such a family, the wife and children face many challenges in the future. With no basis to solve this problem, the whole family was devastated. In this research project, a study will be done on how the family recovered itself during this period and how the family faced the problems and challenges. This type of research is being done to find out the problems in the family and the questions and challenges they face. The research project will be small in size and will be completed in four parts of the year.

(iii) Introduction of the Proposed Study (approx. 400 words)

After coming in contact with people who came to India from abroad, it spread all over India. In fact, the government could have stopped this kind of spread, but the government did not do so and continued to fly for many days. Initially, the virus was limited to a few people. Later, however, due to the negligence of the government and the people, the spread of this virus continued to increase. The government imposed various measures to stop the spread of the virus, but the spread of the virus was increasing and decreasing. This type of research will study the problems and challenges that corona family members face after death. The corpse of a person who died during the Corona period was not given to the family members, his cremation was done in the autopsy room of the hospital, so even the family members could not perform his funeral, it will be analyzed how they suffered. In fact, the family has never had to deal with such incidents before. In fact, in the family, things like intimacy, love, affection, affection are given priority. It is not so easy to digest the fact that the person who lived with us for so many years has just passed away. After a family member leaves, many people try to move away from that person, leaving the family alone. In such a case, if the person has children behind him, then the question of their livelihood arises and the question of how to solve it is a very important issue in the present patriarchal family system. The novelty of this research project is to study the decision made by the person at that time and the analysis of how that decision affected her life.
