
## Best Practice - I

**Best Practice - II**

**1. Title of the Practice: Student Adoption Scheme**

**2. Objective of the Practice:** To graduate first generation learners having economic backward condition.

**3. The Context:** As the college is situated in a rural and tribal area, Most of the students are from Farmer family background where source of income is totally dependent on rain condition of the year. As well as farmers earn money after selling the grains/ things produced at the end of year and that too has many debts of the year. So students faces issues related to money. So, the college has decided to start the "Student Adoption Scheme" for needy students as referred earlier.

**4. The Practice:** In the student adoption scheme family background of student is verified through the committee. Once students are identified to avail the benefit of the scheme at the start of the semester are allocated to the teachers as per the count decided in the teachers meeting. In this scheme, teachers allocated to the students helps them by monetary help of 2000/- rupees per year per student for the payment of college/ examination/ other fees and monthly state transport bus pass fees as required.

**5. Evidence of Success:** It is observed that after the implementation of this student adoption scheme students seen more proactive to pursue their higher education. From the year of implementation of the scheme, 82 students have benefitted and a total amount of rupees 1,41,500/- (One Lac Forty-One Thousand Five Hundred) is spent by the faculty members.

**6. Problems Encountered and Resources Required:** Constraint on number of students to be adopted by the individual teachers.
